

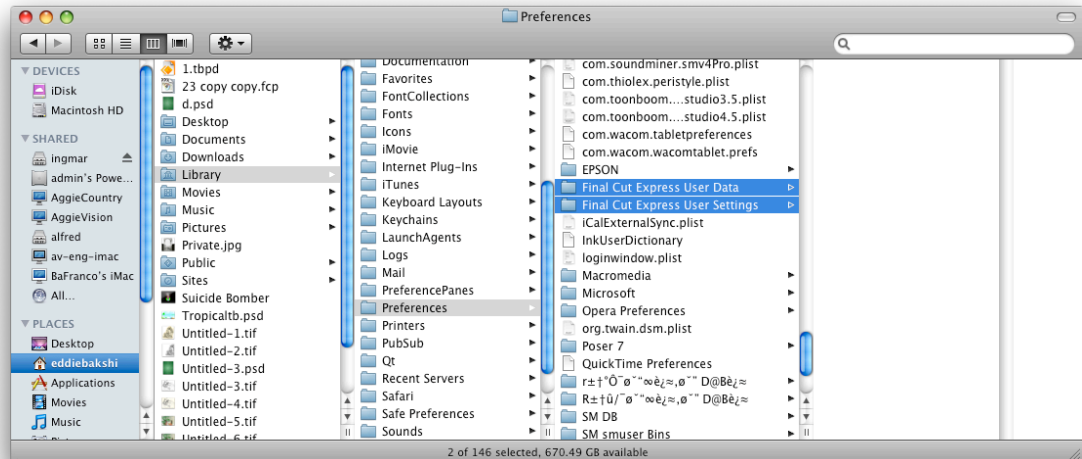
Resetting Final Cut Express

To Reset the Scratch disk, do the following


1. Open **“Finder”** by click the finder icon on the dock
2. Go to your **“Home name directory on the left of the window”**.
3. Click on **“your name/ Library / Preferences/”**
4. Delete 2 Folder and 1 files



After Resetting Final Cut Express, you will need to set the scratch disk by launching Final Cut Express

	<p>Under setup select:</p> <p>For FC Express: HDV-Apple Intermediate Codec 720p30</p> <p>For FC Pro: HDV 720p24</p> <p>Primary Scratch Disk Select your documents folder /your name/Documents</p>

	<p>Make sure the “Do not warn again” is selected and click “Continue”</p>

If you have followed all these steps property, Final Cut Express should launch properly.
